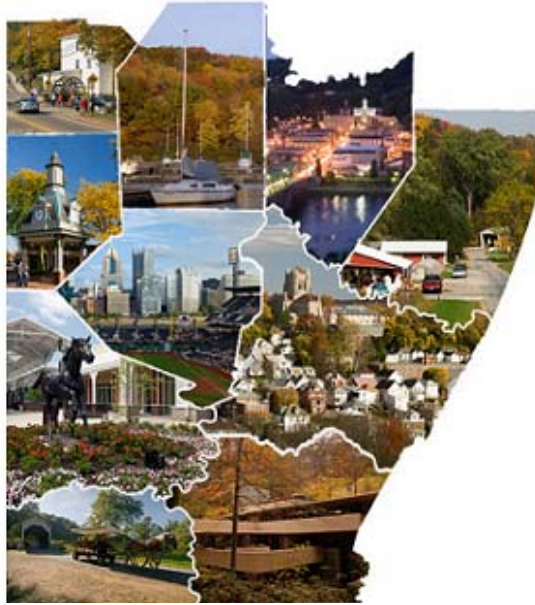
**CommuteInfo Offers Assistance to Job Seekers**
